ScotlandIS member PwC has also committed to reducing its total greenhouse gas emissions by 50% in absolute terms by 2030. This includes a switch to 100% renewable electricity in all territories, as well as energy efficiency improvements in their offices and halving the emissions associated with business travel and accommodation within a decade.

PwC will also invest in carbon removal projects, including natural climate solutions. For every remaining tonne (CO₂ equivalent) that it emits, PwC will remove a tonne of carbon dioxide from the atmosphere to achieve net zero climate impact by 2030.¹

PwC have been globally leading in their thought leadership work on climate tech and will continue to be a key part of the research and policy landscape leading up to COP26.
